 One man from this council, an unknown, will have the courage to take action, Joseph of Arimathea - Matthew 27:57-60

Matthew 26:57-68

- Joseph's courage to take action is recorded by all 4 Gospel writers:
 - Matthew 27:57-60, a disciple (not mentioned until now)
 - Mark 16:43-46, prominent council member
 - John 19:38-39, fear of the Jews
 - Luke 23:50-53, had not consented to their decision

"Now when the chief priests, the elders, And all the council sought false testimony Against Jesus to put Him to death" Matthew 26:59

The text makes us aware of Joseph's

Courage to take action!

- He was a member of the Sanhedrin Council.
- He did not consent to the death of Jesus.
 - He stood against the majority "all the council"
 - He went against the wishes of the High Priest -Matthew 18:12-14, 19-24
- He had the courage to ask Pilate for the body.
- When the disciples forsook Jesus, Joseph stepped up to take care of His body - Matthew 26:56

The text makes us aware of Joseph's

Courage to take action!

- Joseph, joined by Nicodemus, gave Jesus a proper burial:
 - They anointed his body with oil of myrrh and aloes, about 100 pounds - aloe weighs 11.4 pounds per gallon, myrrh (?) - both likely liquid (Ester 2:12)
- He buried Jesus in his own new tomb, fulfilling the prophecy of Isaiah - Isaiah 53:9

Thinking of Joseph, consider, do \underline{I} have... Courage to take action!

- Strong in His might Ephesians 6:19
- Humble, vigilant, steadfast 1 Peter 5:6-9

- Believe in Jesus –
 John 8:24/3:16
- Repent of Sins —
 Luke 13:3-5; Acts 2:38/7:30-31
- Confess your Faith in Jesus –
 Matthew 10:32-33; Romans 10:9
- Baptism for the Remission Of Sins Mark 16:16; Acts 2:38/22:16
- ➤ Live Faithfully for the Remainder of Life Revelation 2:10; James 2:10
 - Remember Matthew 7:21-23 (not everyone, but...)
