AUTONOMY OF THE LOCAL CHURCH

- What is congregational autonomy the direction of the execution of the will of Christ belongs completely within the local church and is not to be surrendered, partially or completely, to any outside control. Elders are to be appointed within each local church (<u>Acts 14:23, Titus 1:5</u>). These elders -(<u>Acts 20:17-28, Titus 1:5-9, I Peter 5:1-2</u>) have the oversight of the congregation of which they are members (<u>I Peter 5:1-2</u>).
- Elders rule under the authority of Christ, the Chief Shepherd (<u>I Timothy 5:17</u>, <u>I Peter 5:1-4</u>). NO passage of Scripture broadens their authority. The elders of the local church have NO right to oversee anything other than the work of the local church where they are members. There is NO authority for a congregation to allow any man, group of men, or organization outside the local church to oversee all or any part of its function.

- From 1985, attendance began to decline.
- From 2000 to 2010, membership declined by 3.73%.
- Since 2015, the Churches of Christ have lost more than 2,000 people and nine congregations per month.

The Churches of Christ lost members at a faster rate than other evangelical Christian denominations.

- <u>Attend</u> No congregation can grow unless its own members attend and actively participate – Hebrews 10:24-25, Acts 20:7, 1 Corinthians 11:18, 20
- Exhort We must be encouraging one another to encourage self growth, which leads to other growth – Hebrews 3:13-15

- Live We need to live like true followers of Jesus, not the denominational standard -Matthew 5:13-16, 1 Thessalonians 4:1-7
- Preach Mark 16:15-16, Matthew 28:18-20
