Paul talks about the last moment in history for mankind when addressing the Corinthians. “In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruptible, and this mortal must put on immortality” (1 Corinthians 15:52-53). On that last day for man and the earth (Matthew 25:31-45) when the earth is destroyed (2 Peter 3:10-13) and Jesus returns at the sound of that trumpet, physical human bodies will cease to exist. Why?
