

FALSE DOCTRINE

Last week: Jesus was just a man while here on the earth.

Praying to Jesus is a FALSE doctrine.

Jesus teaches prayer to God the Father

 Jesus outlines the model prayer – Matthew 6:5-13; Luke 11:1-4 The Only Logical Conclusion

- Both writers record Jesus teaching to pray to "Our Father"
- Jesus repeatedly taught His disciples to pray in His name to God - John 14:13-14; 15:16; 16:23-24
- Paul teaches glorifying God with prayer, by/through Ephesians 3:20-21 (which/that)
- To pray in Jesus' name is to acknowledge that our access to God in prayer comes only <u>through</u> Jesus.

Why necessary to pray through Jesus to God?

 Mankind is not worthy of direct access to God the Father - Romans 3:23
Praving to

 Thus, God sent the Son to be sin -1 Corinthians 5:21

Praying to Jesus is to omit the Glory of God

 Therefore, Jesus came to become God's perfect High Priest, learning obedience as the Son - Hebrews 5:5-11
Praying to Jesus is FALSE Doctrine

 Thereby, Jesus intercedes for His servants – Hebrews 7:27; Romans 8:34; 1 John 2:1

We pray to God the Father <u>NOT</u> to Jesus the Son
