Properly Clothed

▶ **1 Peter 5:5-6**

Can I be clothed spiritually if unclothed physically?

- ▶ **Jeremiah 6:15** – “Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? No! They were not ashamed; Nor did they know how to blush. Therefore, they shall fall among those who fall; at the time I punish them, they shall be cast down, says the Lord.”



Properly Clothed

▶ **1 Peter 5:5-6**

Can I be clothed spiritually if unclothed physically?
Consider what God says...

▶ **Titus 2:3-6**

- ▶ **Reverent in behavior**
- ▶ **To be discreet**
- ▶ **To be chaste**
- ▶ **That the word of God may not be blasphemed**
- ▶ **Likewise, the young men**



Properly Clothed

- ▶ God has expected proper clothing from the beginning
– Genesis 3:6-11
- ▶ Their attempt at minimal clothing did not meet God's standard – Genesis 3:21
- ▶ God's expectation for sufficient clothing is shown for His children under the **Old Law** – Deuteronomy 22:12, Exodus 28:42 (connect application to the New Law: 1 Peter 2:5, 9 & 1 Peter 5:5-6)

Properly Clothed

- ▶ God's expectation for sufficient clothing is shown for His children under the **New Law** – 1 Timothy 2:8-10, 1 Peter 3:1-5 (learn from Jeremiah 6:15)
- ▶ **Chaste** - “pure, decent” (1 Peter 3:2).
- ▶ **Modest** - “orderly, “respectable, decent” (1 Timothy 2:9)
- ▶ **Propriety** - “able to blush, able to be ashamed” (1 Timothy 2:9, Jeremiah 6:15)
- ▶ **Moderation** - “good sense, good judgment” (1 Timothy 2:9, Proverbs 11:22 & 12:4).
- ▶ **Professing godliness** - “doing things that are godly in manner/presentation, pleasing to God” (1 Timothy 2:10).

Properly Clothed

- ▶ God's expectation for sufficient clothing is shown for His children under the **New Law** – 1 Timothy 2:8-10, 1 Peter 3:1-5
- ▶ **Why? Lewdness:** “having or producing unlawful desires (in the mind)” - (Galatians 5:19)
- ▶ We need to be aware of how we can be guilty of contributing to causing another to sin in his or her heart - Matthew 5:28, Matthew 18:7-9
- ▶ A lack of properly being clothed indicates a lack of spiritual growth. Consider also that such is a disrespect and disregard for God and **His** ways.

What must I do to be saved?
