Where does God allow us by word or example to make Him casual?

Reverence: Necessarily Required

- God's Holiness Necessitates Reverence
 - "Holy and awesome" "Reverend" Psalm 111:9
- Nadab and Abihu Sin & Are <u>Punished</u>
 - Their Background Exodus 24:9-11, Leviticus 9:22-24
 - Their Sin Leviticus 10:1-2
- Aaron, Eleazar and Ithamar Sin and Are Pardoned
 - Their Sin Leviticus 10:6,16-20
- Reverence Makes All The Difference!
- Our God, The God, is not to be considered in a casual manner - in worship or in life.

Reverence versus Casual
