


## Thanksgiving - USA

- "I do therefore invite my fellow citizens in every part of the United States, ... to set apart and observe the last Thursday of November next, as a day of Thanksgiving... And I recommend to them that while offering up the ascriptions justly due to Him ..."

## "...and be thankful" Colossians 3:15



- The notion of thanksgiving is solidly based in God's word – Colossians 3:15-17
  - o Ingrained in who God is and what He did Psalm 7:17, 9:1-2, 69:30, 95:1-2, 100:4, 106:1, 107:1
  - Ingrained in who God is and what He <u>does</u> –
     2 Corinthians 4:15, 1 Corinthians 15:17,
     John 16:13-15 (Acts 1:4-8)

- Remember why I am, and enjoy what I enjoy James 1:17-18
- I need to show God my gratitude, submissively Philippians 4:6-7
