

The atheistic agnostic

- An <u>atheist</u> doesn't believe in the existence of a god or divine being. The word <u>atheist</u> originates with the Greek <u>atheos</u>, which is built from the roots <u>a</u>-("without") and <u>theos</u> ("a god"). <u>Atheism</u> is the doctrine or belief that there is no god.
